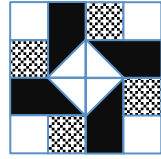


LQG July Block-of-the-Month



For this quilt, use a white tonal or solid white for the background, and red and blue fabrics to give this a patriotic tone. Make one or more of these 12-1/2" blocks and bring them back to the July meeting for the drawing. You could win them all!

White fabric (tone-on-tone or solid): eight 3-1/2" squares

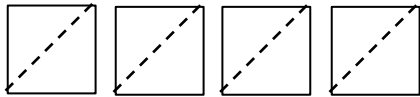


Red print fabric: four 3-1/2" squares

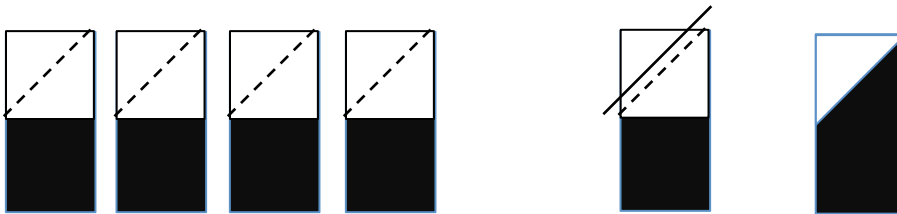


Blue print fabric: four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

Take **four** of the 3-1/2" white squares and mark **one** line on the **wrong** side along the diagonal.



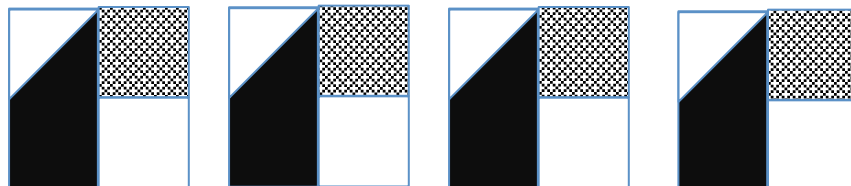
Place these four white 3-1/2" squares right sides together with the blue 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles, as shown. Sew on top of the drawn line. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim 1/4" away from the sewn line, as shown. Open and press.



Take each 3-1/2" red square and pair it with a 3-1/2" white square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" seam along **one** side. Make **four** sets. Open and press.



With right sides together, sew the units together as shown below to make four new units.



Rotate the new units as shown, below. Sew together to complete block.
