

# Longmont Quilt Guild – Block of the Month

## Military Outreach Block



Use a combination of red, white and blue, 100% cotton fabrics

### Center Square:

Cut 1 each – 6 ½" x 6 ½"

### Large Corner Blocks:

Cut 4 each – 3 ½" x 3 ½"

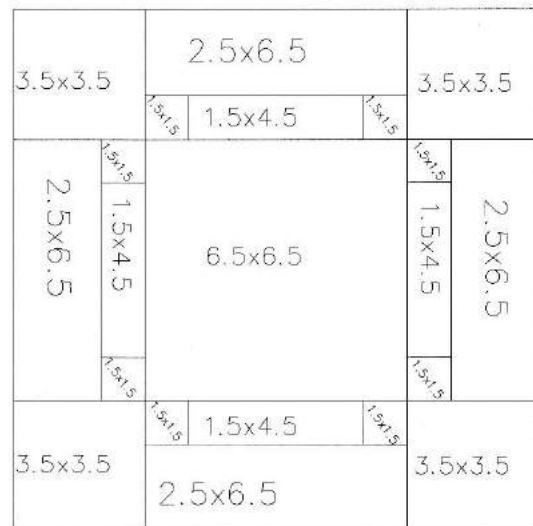
### Small Corner Blocks:

Cut 4 each – 1 ½" x 1 ½"

### White Background Fabric:

Cut 4 each – 2 ½" x 6 ½"

Cut 4 each 1 ½" x 4 ½"



### Piecing Instructions (use a scant ¼" seam):

1. Sew a 1 ½" square to each end of the 1 ½" x 4 ½" strip. Press out toward the 1 ½" square. Finished pieces should measure 1 ½" x 6 ½".
2. Sew each 1 ½" x 6 ½" piece to a 2 ½" x 6 ½" piece. Press toward the 2 ½" piece. Finished pieces should measure 3 ½" x 6 ½".
3. Sew a 3 ½" square to each end of two of the 2 ½" x 6 ½" pieces. Press out toward the 3 ½" square. Finished pieces should measure 3 ½" x 12 ½".
4. Sew two of the 3 ½" x 6 ½" pieces to opposite sides of the 6 ½" square. Press toward the center of the 6 ½" square. Finished piece should measure 6 ½" x 12 ½".
5. Sew a 3 ½" x 12 ½" piece to the top and to the bottom of the 6 ½" x 12 ½" piece, nesting seams. Finished size of the block should be 12 ½" x 12 ½".
