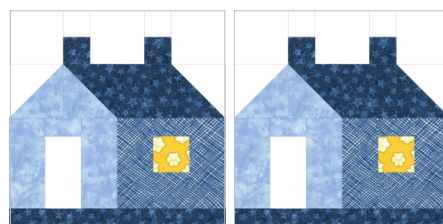


# Longmont Quilt Guild 2020 Block-of-the-Month

## January Block | House of Blues



### Fabrics

#### A | Medium to Dark Blue Print

- One 4-inch square
- One 3-1/2-inch square
- Two 2-inch squares
- One 1-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch rectangle

#### B | White

- One 4-inch square
- Two 2-inch squares
- Three 3-1/2-inch squares
- One 2-1/2 x 4-1/2-inch rectangle

#### C | Light Blue Print

- One 4-inch square
- Two 2-1/2 x 5-1/2-inch rectangles
- One 1-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch rectangle

#### D | Medium Blue Print

- Two 2-1/2 x 5-1/2-inch rectangles
- One 2-1/2 x 1-1/2-inch rectangle
- One 2-1/2-inch square

#### E | Yellow, white, or fussy cut print for window

- One 2-1/2-inch square

### Assembly

Take one each A and B fabric 2-inch squares and sew together, right sides together, along one side. Make 2 units.



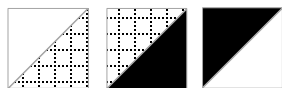
Take the three B fabric 3-1/2-inch squares and sew, right sides together, with units just created as shown:



For A, B, and C fabric 4-inch squares, cut each square *once* across the diagonal.



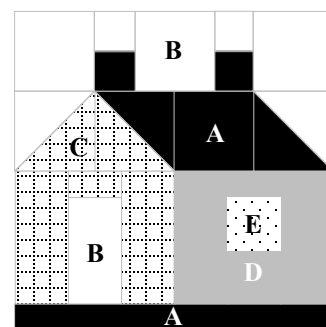
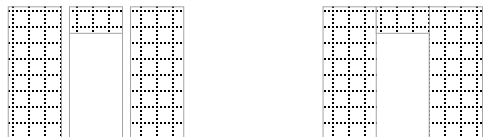
Pair them up, right sides together: A & B, B & C, A & C, and sew scant 1/4-inch away from the diagonal to form three half-square-triangle (HST) units as shown below. Carefully press, and square up to 3-1/2 inches so that the seam line is on the diagonal corner to corner.



Using these three HST units, along with the 3-1/2-inch square A fabric, sew, right sides together, as shown:



Take the B fabric 2-1/2 x 4-1/2-inch rectangle and C fabric 1-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch rectangle and sew, right sides together, along one 2-1/2-inch side. Take the two 2-1/2 x 6-1/2-inch C fabric rectangles, and assemble as shown below:



Take the D fabric 2-1/2-inch square and E fabric 2-1/2-inch square and sew, right sides together, along one side. Take the D fabric 2-1/2 x 1-1/2-inch rectangle and sew this to the E fabric end. Take the two 2-1/2 x 6-1/2-inch D fabric rectangles, and sew together as shown below:



Sew these two units together as shown below:



You are now ready to put your whole house o' blues together!

Arrange all the units as shown below, adding the A fabric 1-1/2 x 12-1/2-inch rectangle to the bottom:
