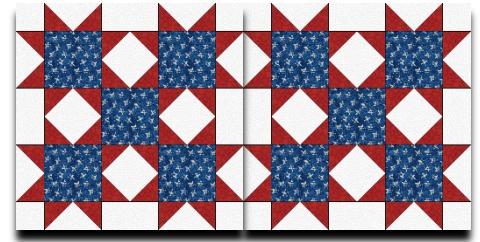


Longmont Quilt Guild 2020 Block-of-the-Month

July Block | Glory Stars (12-1/2-inch block)



Fabrics

A | White

- Four 3-1/2-inch squares
- Twelve 3-1/2-inch x 2-inch rectangles
- Four 2-inch squares

C | Red

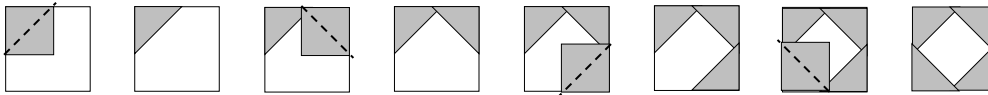
- Thirty-two 2-inch squares
- (Mark on the diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of each square)

B | Blue

- Five 3-1/2-inch squares

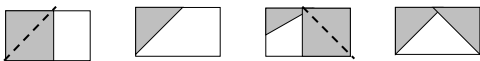
Make Snowball Units (Yields 4)

This unit uses all four 3-1/2-inch White (A) squares and 16 Red (C) 2-inch squares. On each White square, place a Red 2-inch square, right sides together, in one corner of the White square. Align raw edges, and sew on the diagonal line on the back of the Red square. Trim 1/4 inch from the sewn line toward the corner, and press seam allowance toward the Red fabric. Repeat this on the remaining three corners of each White square.



Make Flying Geese (Yields 8)

Pair eight of the 3-1/2-inch x 2-inch White rectangle with two 2-inch Red squares. For each unit, with right sides together, place one Red square to one end of the White rectangle and sew ON the marked line on the back of the Red fabric. Cut on 1/4 inch away from the stitched line toward the corner. Repeat this step for the other end of the White rectangle.



Assemble Block

Lay out all the units and remaining 3-1/2-inch Blue squares, 3-1/2-inch x 2-inch White rectangles, and 1-1/2-inch White squares as shown below, and sew together.
