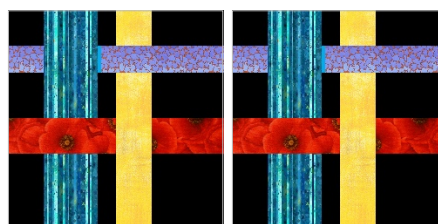

Fabrics

Please see diagram below to help cut directional fabric correctly.

Background | Black Fabric

- A1: 2-1/2 x 3-inch rectangle
- A3: 2-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch square
- B1: 1-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch rectangle
- B3: 4-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch rectangle
- C1: 2-1/2 x 4-1/2-inch rectangle
- C3: 1-1/2 x 4-1/2-inch rectangle
- D1: 4-1/2 x 4-1/2-inch square
- D3: 4-1/2 x 3-inch square
- E: 1-1/2 x 3-inch rectangle

Bright Fabric 1 (Left vertical stripe)

- A4: 3-1/2 x 6-1/2-inch rectangle
- C2: 3-1/2 x 4-1/2-inch rectangle

Bright Fabric 2 (Top horizontal stripe)

- A2: 2-1/2 x 2-inch rectangle
- B4: 7-1/2 x 2-inch rectangle

Bright Fabric 3 (Right vertical stripe)

- B2: 2-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch square
- D4: 2-1/2 x 9-inch rectangle

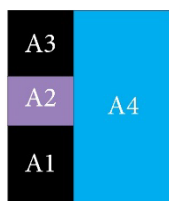
Bright Fabric 4 (Lower horizontal stripe)

- C4: 6-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch rectangle
- D2: 4-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch rectangle

Assembly

This block is put together into units, which are then sewn together with partial seams.

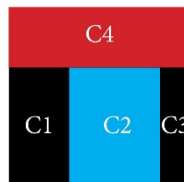
Block A: Gather A1, A2, A3, and A4 pieces.
Sew together as shown:



Block B: Gather B1, B2, B3, and B4 pieces.
Sew together as shown:



Block C: Gather C1, C2, C3, and C4 pieces.
Sew together as shown:



Block D: Gather D1, D2, D3, and D4 pieces.
Sew together as shown:



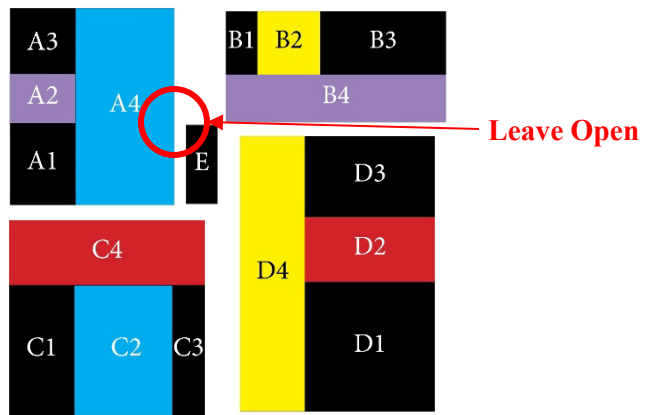
Lay out the blocks and the E piece as shown (See **Example 01**). Right sides together, sew E to bottom right corner of A4, LEAVE OPEN $\frac{1}{2}$ - to $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch allowance at the top of the E piece. (See **Examples 02 & 03**)

Sew C4 to A Block. (See **Example 04**)

Sew D4 onto new block. (See **Example 05**)

Sew B Block to D Block. (See **Example 06**)

Finally, sew B Block to A Block, making sure to catch the top of the E piece.
