Fabrics

Background | Black Fabric
Four 4-inch squares

Bright Fabrics 1, 2, 3

From EACH of three different bright fabrics (C1, C2, C3), cut:
Four 4-inch squares

Assembly

Make the Half-Square Triangles

On the WRONG side of each of the four C1 and C3 4-inch squares, mark one line across the diagonal.

Pair up the squares as follows, right sides together:

Two Background (B) and two C1 squares
Two C1 and two C2 squares
Two C2 and two C3 squares
Two C3 and two Background (B) squares.

Sew a scant quarter inch along both sides of the drawn lines (on the wrong sides of the C1 and C3 squares), then cut ON the line to create 16 total half square triangles. Carefully square these up to 3-1/2 inches with the diagonal line on the ruler along the seam.

Arrange the Units and Assemble Block

Lay out the units as shown below. Sew the units into rows, then sew the rows together to complete the block.
