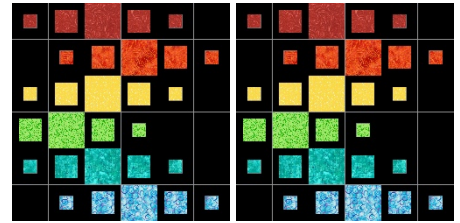

Fabrics

Background | Black Fabric

- Twenty-four 1-1/8-inch x 1-1/4-inch rectangles (Block A)
- Twenty-four 1-1/8-inch x 2-1/2-inch rectangles (Block A)
- Twenty-four 7/8-inch x 1-3/4-inch rectangles (Block B)
- Twenty-four 7/8-inch x 2-1/2-inch rectangles (Block B)
- Six 2-1/2-inch squares (Block D)

Bright Fabrics – 6 Different Fabrics (F1 to F6)

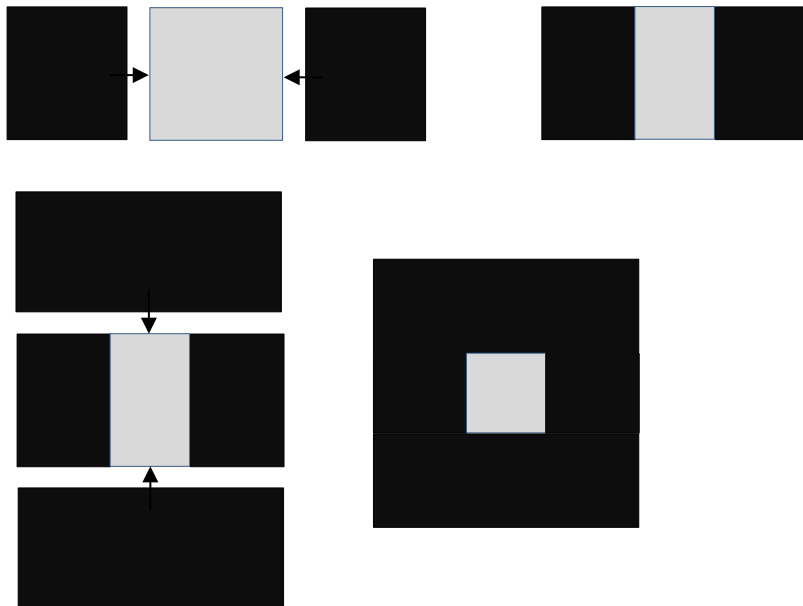
- Cut from EACH of 6 different bright fabrics:
- Two 1-1/4-inch squares (Block A)
- Two 1-3/4-inch squares (Block B)
- One 2-1/2-inch square (Block C)

Please note that each row has a different bright color.

Block A

Make *two* of these for each of the Bright Fabrics, F1-F6 for a total of 12 Block As.

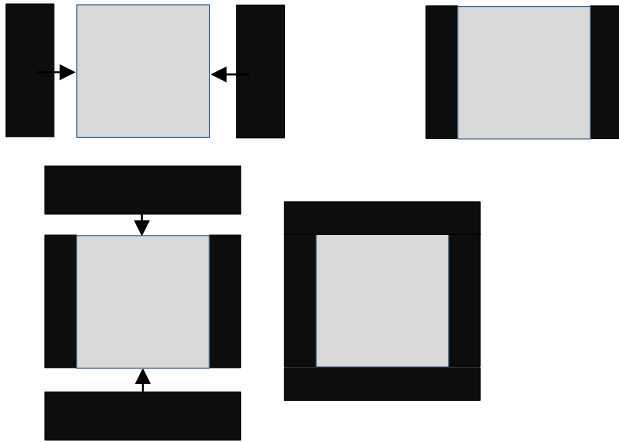
For each unit, sew one 1-1/8-inch x 1-1/4-inch Background fabric piece to each side of each 1-1/4-inch square Bright fabrics. Press seam allowance toward the Bright fabric. Sew one 1-1/8-inch x 2-1/2-inch Background rectangle to the top and bottom of the units just sewn. Press toward the Background fabric.



Block B

Make *two* of these for each of the Bright Fabrics, F1-F6 for a total of 12 Block Bs.

For each unit, sew one 7/8-inch x 1-3/4-inch Background fabric piece to each side of each 1-3/4-inch square Bright fabrics. Press seam allowance toward the Bright fabric. Sew one 7/8-inch x 2-1/2-inch Background rectangle to the top and bottom of the units just sewn. Press toward the Background fabric.



Block Placement

Assemble the units as shown below, making sure the Bright fabrics in the rows are the same, for example, red in the top row, green in the second row, etc. Sew the rows, then sew the rows to each other to form the block. Please note, you will have one of the Block A and Block B units left over.
