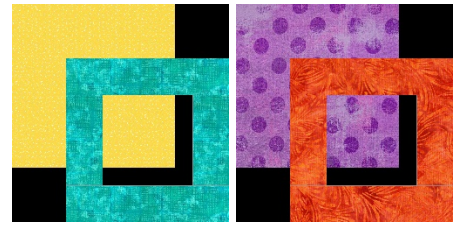

Fabrics

Background | Black Fabric

- Two 3-1/2-inch squares
- One 4-1/2 x 1-1/2-inch rectangle
- One 5-1/2 x 1-1/2-inch rectangle

Bright Fabric 2 (F2)

- One 4-1/2-inch square
- One 6-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch rectangle
- One 9-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch rectangle

Bright Fabric 1 (F1)

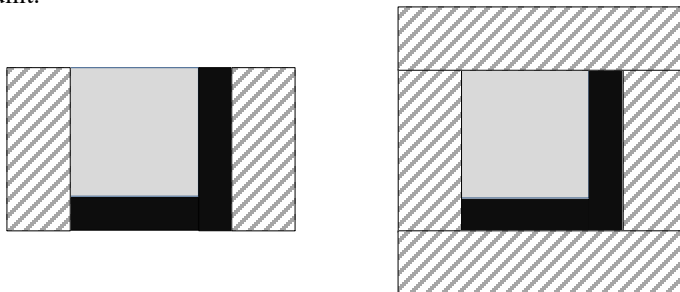
- Two 9-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch rectangle
- Two 5-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch rectangle

Assemble Block

Right sides together, sew the 4-1/2 x 1-1/2-inch Background rectangle along one side of the 4-1/2-inch F2 square. With the unit's black strip along the bottom, right sides together, sew the 5-1/2 x 1-1/2-inch Background rectangle on the right side of this unit. See illustration below.



As shown below, right sides together, sew each of the two 5-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch F1 rectangles along the right and left sides of the previous unit. Next, right sides together, sew each of the two 9-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch F2 rectangles along the top and bottom of this unit.



Right sides together, sew one 3-1/2-inch Background square to the 6-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch F2 rectangle along one of the short (3-1/2 inch) sides. Repeat this with the second 3-1/2-inch Background square and the 9-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch F2 rectangle.



Arrange all units as shown below. Starting with the shorter rectangle unit on the left, right sides together, sew this to the unit to the right square unit. Then, right sides together, sew new unit to the rectangle unit along the top.
