

Scrappy Four-Patch - Longmont Quilt Guild

- Quilt finishes 38 ½" x 62 ½"

Fabric Requirements and Cutting Instructions:

From either scraps or coordinating fabrics, cut a total of (60) 5 ½" x 5 ½" squares.

Sashing and borders: 1 yard

Sashing:

Cut (3) strips 2 ½" x WOF. Subcut (10) rectangles for sashing – 2 ½" x 10 ½".

Cut (6) strips 2 ½" x WOF for horizontal sashing strips.

Border:

Cut (4) strips 2 ½" x WOF.

Sewing Instructions:

1. Sew (4) 5 ½" squares into a four-patch block, pressing seams to one side. Blocks should measure 10 ½" square – trim if necessary. Repeat for a total of (15) blocks.



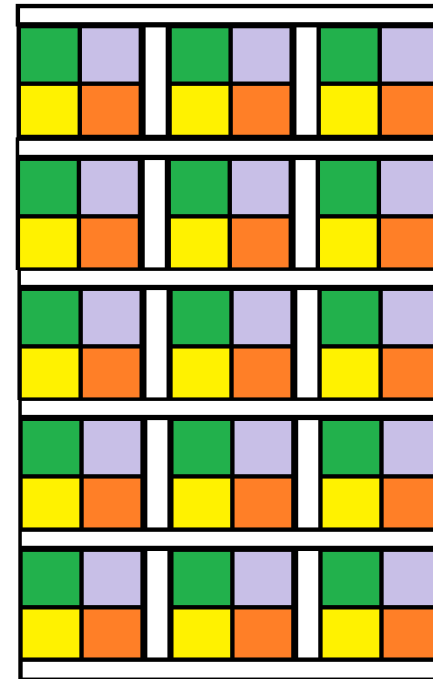
2. Sew (3) blocks together with a sashing rectangle between the blocks to make a row. Repeat for a total of (5) rows. Press seams toward the sashing strips.



3. Sew one horizontal sashing strip to the top edge of each row.



4. Sew the rows together, pressing seams toward the sashing strips. Sew the final horizontal sashing strip to the bottom edge of the quilt center.



5. Sew (4) strips together on the short ends, making one long strip. Press seams to one side. From this long strip, cut (2) strips 2 ½" x 62 ½". Sew these strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Press seams toward the long strips.
