March | Corner Cross



Fabrics (for each BOM)

Background | Beige/Off-White Fabric

- Four 2-1/2-inch squares
- Four 2-1/2-inch x 4-1/2-inch rectangles
- Four 2-1/2-inch x 6-1/2-inch rectangles

Medium Print

- Eight 2-1/2-inch squares

Dark Print

- Four 2-1/2-inch squares

<p><u>For BOM Lottery:</u></p> <p>Make 1 or more for 1 or more chances to win the blocks</p>	<p><u>For Your Sampler Quilt:</u></p> <p>The block shown here represents two units for your sampler quilt. You will make 4 units total, equivalent of 1 block. <i>Please note in directions below where it says to stop sewing units together for the Sampler.</i></p>
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Make Corner Four-Patches

Pair one Dark 2-1/2-inch square with one Medium 2-1/2-inch square, right sides together, and sew along one side. Press seam allowance toward Medium fabric. Repeat with the remaining three Dark 2-1/2-inch squares and three of the Medium 2-1/2-inch squares. Now pair one Background 2-1/2-inch square with one Medium 2-1/2-inch square. With right sides together, sew along one side, and press seam allowance toward the Medium fabric. Repeat with the remaining Background and Medium 2-1/2-inch squares.

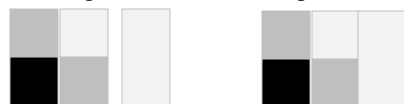


Take one Dark/Medium unit and pair with one Background/Medium unit so that the Medium fabrics are not faced together and so that the pressed seams nest together. Sew these two units along one side and press seam allowance. Repeat with the remaining six units to yield four of the corner four patches.



Complete Corner Units and Assemble Block

Take one four-patch unit just sewn, and lay it out with one Background 2-1/2-inch x 4-1/2-inch rectangle, as shown below. Sew together as shown. Repeat with the remaining three four-patch units and Background 2-1/2-inch x 4-1/2-inch rectangles.



Take each of the units just sewn, and pair with one Background 2-1/2-inch x 6-1/2-inch rectangle as shown below. Sew together. Repeat for the remaining units to yield four total complete corner units. (*Note: Stop here for these blocks for your Sampler.*)



To complete your block, lay out each of the four units as shown below. Sew together.
