### April | Ten-Four



#### Fabrics (for each BOM)

##### **Background | Beige/Off-White Fabric**

Two 6-1/2-inch squares

##### **Dark Print**

Four 3-1/2-inch squares

##### **Medium Print**

Four 3-1/2-inch squares

<p><u>For BOM Lottery:</u></p> <p>Make 1 or more for 1 or more chances to win the blocks</p>	<p><u>For Your Sampler Quilt:</u></p> <p>Make 8 blocks</p>
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#### Make Four-Patches

Pair each Dark 3-1/2-inch square with one Medium 2-1/2-inch square. Sew along one side. Press toward Dark fabric. Take one unit just sewn, and pair with another unit, right sides together, Dark facing Medium fabrics, and nesting the seams. Sew together along one long side to create your four patch. Repeat for the remaining two units. This yields two four-patch units.



#### Assemble Block

Lay out the four patches just sewn along with the 6-1/2-inch Background squares as shown below. You want to make sure the Dark squares form a line across the diagonal of the final block. Sew these units together to complete the block.
