Fabrics (Makes two BOM)

Background | Beige/Off-White Fabric

One 13-1/2-inch square

Medium Print

Two 4-1/2-inch x 2-1/2-inch rectangles

Two 8-1/2-inch x 2-1/2-inch rectangles

Dark Print

One 4-1/2-inch square

Two 8-1/2-inch x 3-inch rectangles

Two 13-1/2-inch x 3-inch rectangles

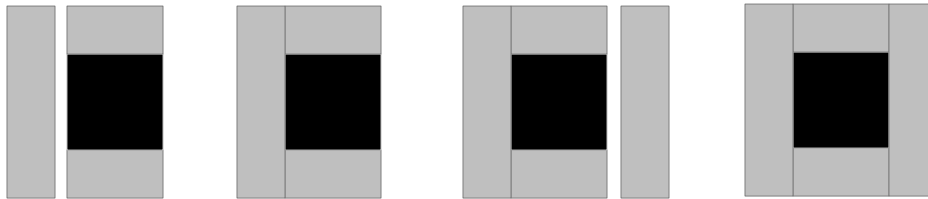

Make the Cabin Block

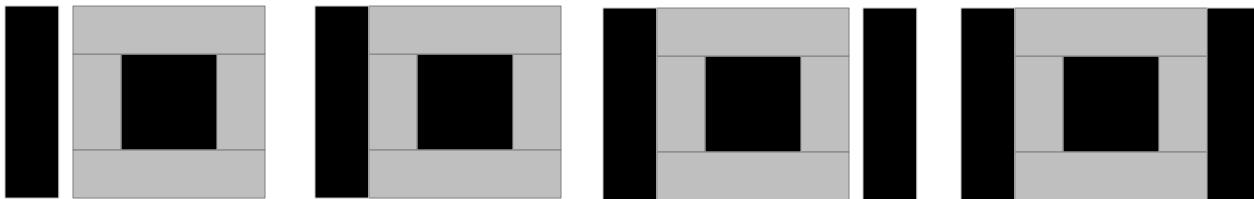
The Dark 4-1/2-inch square will be the center of this block. Right sides together, sew each Medium 4-1/2-inch x 2-1/2-inch rectangle on either side of the Dark 4-1/2-inch square.



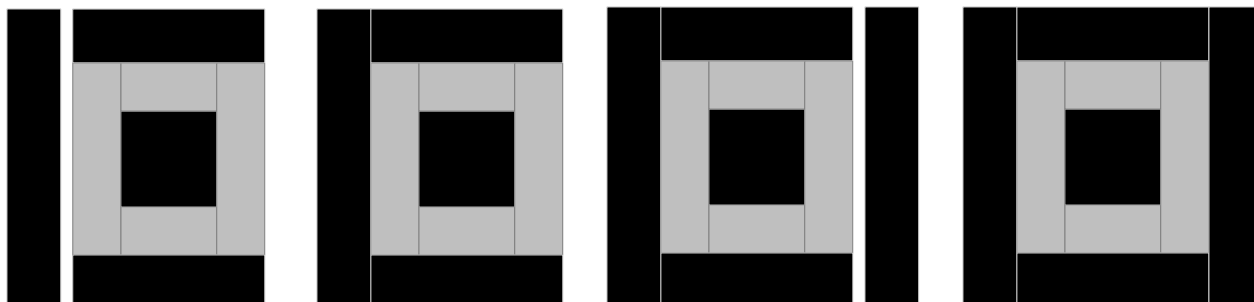
Right sides together, sew each Medium 8-1/2-inch x 2-1/2-inch rectangle on either side of the unit just completed.



Right sides together, sew each Dark 8-1/2 x 3-inch rectangle on either side of the unit just completed.



Right sides together, sew each Dark 13-1/2 x 3-inch rectangle on either side of the unit just completed.



Finish Block

Mark one line across the diagonal on the wrong side of the Background 13-1/2-inch square. With the right sides together, line up the 13-1/2-inch Background square with the completed cabin block. Sew a scant 1/4 inch on either side of your marked line. Cut on the line, and press the seam allowance toward the darker side. Carefully square each of the two blocks up to 12-1/2 inches, making sure the diagonal seam line aligns with the 45-degree line on your ruler.
